# Eligibility:

- PSNZ affiliated Clubs in the North Island of New Zealand
  - Where a club or society has 40 or more members, each digital image in the selection must be made by a different club member.
  - Where a club or society has less than 40 members, then a maximum of two members may enter two images in the selection only if it's necessary to make up the selection.
  - Images entered in this competition in any previous year are ineligible.

**Entries:** An entry in the competition shall be made by a club or society only, and shall consist of a selection of six (6) digital images. There are no requirements for a set and each image will be classified as open.

## **Online Entry Form:** Both print and digital entries **MUST** be entered using the <u>online form</u>

- Images must be saved as a JPEG file with the size for:
  - **Landscape Orientation Digital Images** being up to a **maximum** size of 3840px on the horizontal width and 2160px on the vertical side.
  - **Portrait Orientation Digital Images** being up to a **maximum** size of 2160px on the vertical side.
- Images must be saved in the sRGB colour space.
- All digital images must be titled.
- The photographer's name and appropriate PSNZ Honours must be identified on the online Entry Form alongside each image title.
- Entry Form Link: North Island Interclub Salon

- 1. All Image entries must be submitted through the online entry system.
- 2. Entrants must have appropriate **rights and permission** relating to the subject matter of their entries.
- 3. Entries must be 100% photographic and all elements must be produced by the entrant, including materials for composite images.
- 4. No image created solely by, or containing elements, created using Generative Artificial Intelligence are permitted.
- 5. All **post production** must be executed by the photographer.
- 6. The organising committee may request entrants to submit all of the original files generated from the camera, and any multi layers image created in post-production.
- 7. Please do not add any watermarks to your entries as the judging is anonymous. All entries with watermarks on will be disqualified.
- 8. The copyright of all images remains with the entrant. The organisers' reserve the right to reproduce, without payment, any image in connection with the exhibition.
- 9. The Photographic Society of New Zealand Inc accepts no responsibility for any claims relating to your copyright or privacy infringement or disputes.
- 10. The organisers' reserve the right to disqualify an entry that they consider, at their absolute discretion, to be undesirable.
- 11. The judges' decisions are final. Submission of an entry implies acceptance of the Salon rules.
